

# Information for tenants

It is important to sort your waste correctly to help create a more sustainable environment. In Borgholm Municipality, waste is separated into food waste, residual waste, packaging, and newspapers, which should be placed in the designated bins on the property. Small electronics, batteries, and light bulbs should be placed in the designated electronics box. Bulky waste must be taken to a recycling center.

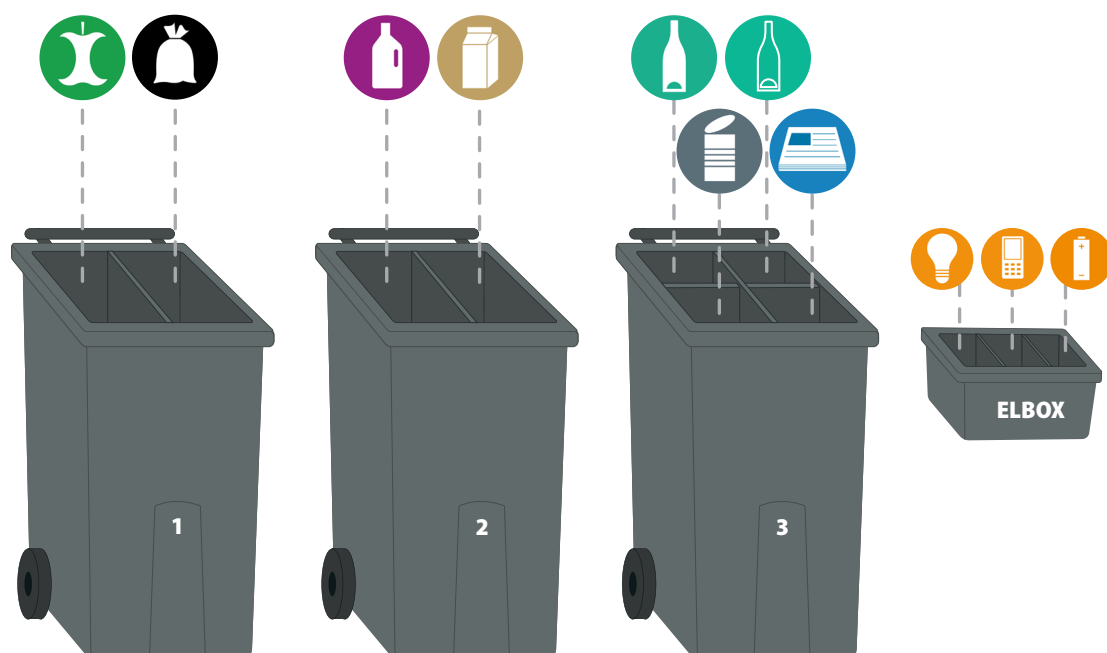
## Garbage collection schedule

Bin 1 and 2 are emptied every two weeks, while bin 3 is emptied every eight weeks. If you would like the electronics box to be emptied, hang it in front of bin 3, otherwise it should be stored indoors.

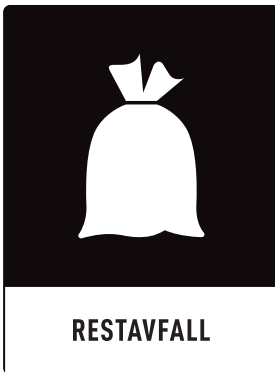

## Important information

- Food waste must be placed in the paper bag provided by Borgholm Energi.
- Residual waste should be placed in any plastic bag and tied with a double knot before being placed in the bin.
- Place the bin with the back facing the road on collection day.
- Put the bin out no later than 06:00 on collection day.
- The lid of the bin must be able to close completely.
- If you need new food waste bags, you can tie any bag around the handle or place a food waste bag under the lid of the bin on collection day.



# How to sort the waste in bin 1 & 2



- ✓ Diaper, envelope, dishcloth, nicotine pouch, toothbrush and hair from hairbrushes.
- ✗ Nothing that can be recycled should be put in the residual waste. Hazardous waste and electrical waste should be taken to a recycling center unless the electrical waste can be put in the electronics box.



- ✓ Fruit and vegetable peel, tea bag, coffee ground, eggshell and meat bone.
- ✗ Plastic, nicotine pouch, cigarette, flowers and candle wax are not food waste.



- ✓ Pasta, milk and juice packages, paper bag, shoe box, toilet roll, egg carton and smaller corrugated boxes.
- ✗ Envelopes are placed in the residual waste. Newspaper, flyer and similar items are placed in the newspaper container.



- ✓ Plastic bottle, plastic can, plastic bag, plastic refill pack, plastic tubes, plastic chip bags and Styrofoam.
- ✗ Plastic products that are not packaging are taken to a recycling center. Returnable bottles are turned in at a grocery store for deposit.

## How to sort the waste in bin 3



- ✓ Bottles and jars made of colored or uncolored glass. Remove caps, lids, and corks and sort them by material. Sort colored and uncolored glass packaging into the correct container.



- ✗ Returnable bottles are deposited in grocery stores. Porcelain, ceramics and other products that are not packaging are taken to a recycling center.



- ✓ Tin can, empty spray can, tube, caps, lids and empty paint cans.
- ✗ Cans containing paint and glue residues are taken to a recycling center as hazardous waste. Scrap metal, plumbing parts and frying pans are taken to a recycling center.



- ✓ Newspaper, magazine, catalog, flyer, brochure and writing/drawing paper.
- ✗ Envelopes are placed in the residual waste.
